LiveWell Greenville and City of Greenville Partnership Facts:

The City of Greenville was able to hire a Recreation Supervisor to manage the coordination of the MobiRec and Play Streets programs to create safe play spaces for more than **16,000** children over a three year period.

The City used the Park Audit Study (Examining Disparities in Park Availability, Features and Quality Across Greenville County) to determine the locations with the greatest need for increased access to physical activity - or play deserts, and expand these programs and their reach into the community.

These successful initiatives were frequently utilized at City of Greenville Community Centers, **ALL** of which are recognized as [LiveWell Out of School Time](#) programs, where they implement researched based best practices in health and wellness.

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
